

# BIOMARQ™ Biopsy Container 20 ml (MBC20-F)

## INTENDED USE

The MedSchenker BIOMARQ Biopsy Container is intended for the preservation of biopsies from the collection site to the testing laboratory. The maximum volume of the biopsy to be preserved is 1 cm<sup>3</sup>.

#### CONTENTS

4% Formaldehyde in aqueous solution (10% formalin solution) and <2,5% methanol, 20 ml

### STORAGE TEMPERATURE

### PROCEDURE FOR SAMPLING


- > Wear protective medical gloves (Butyl or Nitrile)
- > Unscrew the blue lid, being careful not to loosen the top lid



> Take the biopsy and place it in the container



> Close the BIOMARQ Biopsy Container by screwing the lid onto the container. The lid must be screwed all the way on



 Release the formalin by slightly tilting the container and slowly unscrewing the top lid.
 Check that the biopsy is completely exposed to the formalin



- > Put a label with patient data and other relevant information on the BIOMARQ Biopsy Container according to local procedures
- > Send the BIOMARQ Biopsy Container for analysis according to local procedures for the shipment of diagnostic samples
